Republican Party leaders have focused on recruiting a new cadre of top-notch candidates, building new volunteer networks, and forging new working relationships both within and outside the Party.

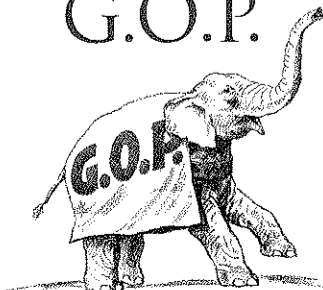

The Medina County Republican Party has launched a **Voter Registration Initiative** to make it convenient for residents to register before the November 2 Election. The deadline for registration is October 4. This is a strictly non-partisan effort.

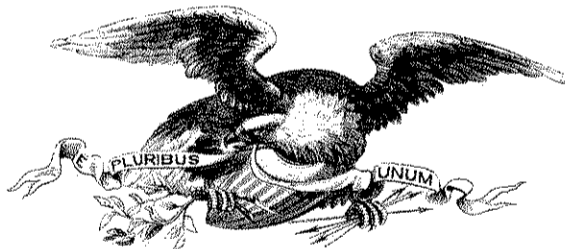
