

## A FEW FACTS ABOUT ERIC CHUNG (MI-10)

### HIGHLIGHTS

#### **CHUNG MISREPRESENTED HIS TIES TO MI-10, PAID HIMSELF A CAMPAIGN SALARY, AND MAY HAVE VOTED ILLEGALLY IN MICHIGAN DURING NEARLY TWO DECADES LIVING OUT OF STATE**

- Chung’s campaign told the media that he “lives in the community he grew up in, in Sterling Heights.” and has implied that he grew up in Michigan’s Tenth District. In fact, Chung never lived in the district until he moved there in 2025 after sixteen years out of state.
- Chung grew up in Madison Heights, not Sterling Heights. He left Michigan for school in 2010 and hasn’t lived there since, instead buying a \$1 million home in Washington, DC and claiming a tax break intended for District of Columbia homeowners whose property is their primary residence.
- However, even as he saved thousands by claiming that tax break, Chung continued to vote at his parents’ address in Madison Heights, potentially running afoul of Michigan’s requirement that only state residents vote in state elections. Reporting indicates that Chung may also have been registered to vote in Washington, DC during his time there.
- Chung moved back to Michigan just to run for Congress. In 2025, he quit his lucrative legal job in DC and moved to Sterling Heights, MI where he rented an apartment and began paying himself a bimonthly salary out of his campaign account. To date, Chung’s campaign has paid him more than \$30,000 in combined salary and reimbursements.

#### **CHUNG’S CAMPAIGN IS POWERED BY DONATIONS FROM CALIFORNIA, NEW YORK, AND DC – NOT MICHIGAN GRASSROOTS**

- More than \$700,000 of Chung’s total fundraising haul came from donors in California, New York and DC, representing more than 50% of his total dollars raised. By contrast, Chung raised less than \$75k from donors in Michigan.
- Chung raised more than \$300,000 from donors identified as “lawyers or lobbyists,” the most out of any candidate in the MI-10 Democratic primary.

#### **CHUNG WORKED FOR A TALENT COMPANY THAT PROMOTED MAGA INFLUENCERS, HELD STOCK IN ELON MUSK’S TESLA, AND DISCLOSED PROFITS FROM A MUTUAL FUND THAT INCLUDED HOLDINGS IN PALANTIR AND OVERSEAS COMPANIES**

- Chung disclosed nearly \$20,000 in income from working as a legal consultant for Underscore Talent, a company that primarily represents online creators.
- Underscore Talent represents Cole and Savannah LaBrant, an influencer couple who publicly supported Donald Trump in 2024. In 2022, the couple posted a “documentary” about abortion on their YouTube channel which compared abortion to the Holocaust. When asked about the backlash, Cole LaBrant said that it was “worth it” if it saved “just one baby.”
- In his personal financial disclosure, Chung disclosed capital gains from Tesla stock and profit from investments in a tech-focused mutual fund with holdings in Palantir, an ICE contractor. The mutual fund also held stakes in overseas company, including hundreds of millions invested in Taiwanese and Israeli companies, leaving Chung open to potential primary attacks on outsourcing and Gaza.

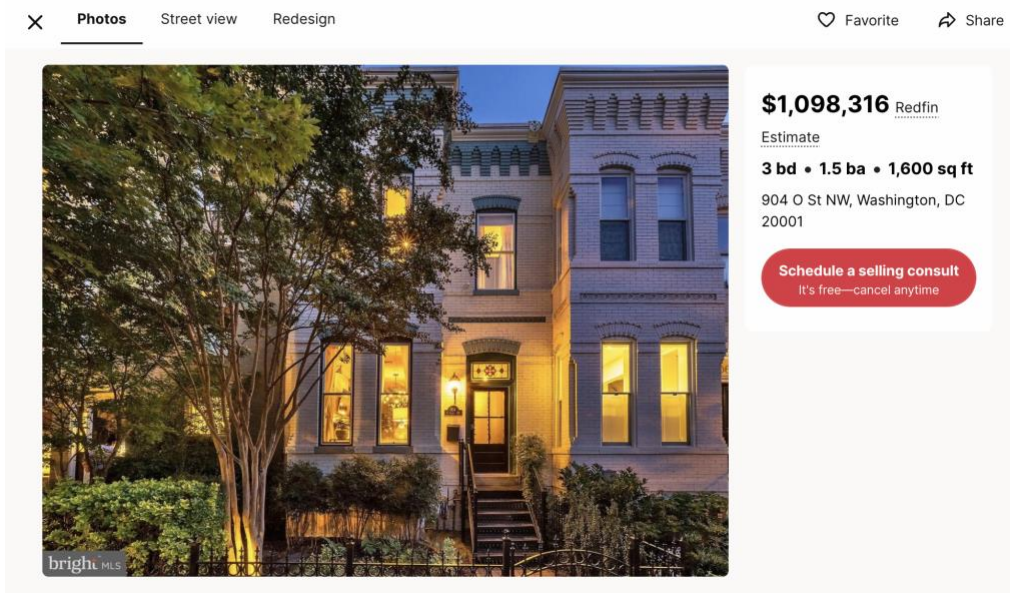

**TO QUALIFY FOR A DC HOMESTEAD DEDUCTION, A PROPERTY MUST BE THE PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE OF THE OWNER**

**To Qualify For A DC Homestead Deduction, A Homeowner Must Affirm That The Property Is The “Principal Residence (Domicile)” Of The Owner.** “The Homestead Deduction is limited to residential property. To qualify and maintain the deduction: An application must be on file with the Office of Tax and Revenue; (If the property owner lives in a cooperative housing association, the cooperative management or representative will supply and collect the application.) 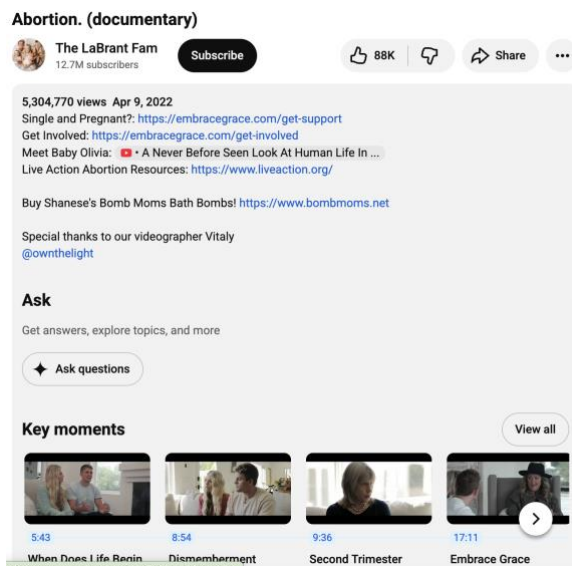
